

Now is Not Too Early to Begin Scheduling Important Physical Examination and Immunization Appointments for 2017-2018!

All students must be up-to-date with physical examination and immunization requirements. All forms must be turned into the School Health Office prior to **August 1st**. **Students will not be able to attend school until all required health information is on file.**

Important Health Requirements for 2017-2018

Students entering **Early Childhood, Kindergarten, Sixth and Ninth grades** are required to have a current physical examination completed on the approved Illinois Department of Public Health Form. A sport physical does not meet the requirement. A current physical is one that was completed within one year of August 2017. The parent portion on the upper back side of the form must be completed and signed. **Students entering grade 12** in the State of Illinois must be immunized for Meningitis. The immunization requirement consists of two doses of the MCV4 vaccine for entry into 12th grade. *Only one dose of the MCV4 is required for students entering 12th grade if the first dose was received on/after the age of 16.*

Immunization records can be viewed through the Parent Infinite Campus Portal. Physical examination forms are available in all School Health Offices and on the D300 Health Services website.
