Severe incidents that warrant multiple day ISI's, full-day Bus Suspension for safety concerns, In-School Suspension, and/or Out of School Suspension may exclude a student from participating in not only the individual activities above, but multiple activities as well. This will be handled at the discretion of the AMS administration.

*Severe discipline issues may also result in the loss of participating in Eighth Grade Recognition Night.*
